The other is co-organized by Francis Rumsey and Dan Ellis and concerns the common ground between Spatial Audio and Computational Audio Scene Analysis. Both these events are proposed to be re-run at the 119th in New York, though possibly as Invited Paper sessions.

ACTIONS: Mark & Dan/Francis to propose events to Convention organizers.
